Knitting Basics

Learn casting on, the knit & purl stitches, increases, decreases and binding off. \$45 class fee.

Crochet Basics

Learn to chain, single, double crochet and other basic crochet stitches. \$25 class fee includes hook and yarn.

This stunning mosaic stitch coat is featured in the Vogue Holiday issue. The oversized design is worked in contrasting shades of worsted weight yarn and has optical illusion zigzag motifs in a large scale swirling pattern on top and smaller scale patterning below the waist. \$55 class fee.



Designer Véronik Avery has a great eye for proportion and sweater detail. She combines an unusual shoulder line and a simple, classic stitch pattern to create a never-go-out-of-style, live-in-it cardigan.

Looking for a portable project? Socks may be the answer - especially when you knit them on an Addi Turbo's 12" circular needle! And most of the time you won't even have to use those pesky double pointed needles!

Learn knitting in the round and how to work two different decreases. \$75 class fee includes sock yarn, pattern, and both a 12" circular and dpns.

Cabled Pullover

An otherwise simple crew-neck sweater gets a twist with three columns of cables along both the front and the back. Ribbing on the neck, hemline and sleeve cuffs offers a polished edge.

Although it can be worked in any DK weight yarn, the sweater looks fabulous as shown here worked in Butterfly Super 10 cotton. \$50 class fee includes the pattern.

Socks - Beyond the Basics

Socks - Beyond the Basics is a series of classes for the experienced sock knitter. Over five classes, we will explore fit and sizing, discuss a variety of cast-ons, heels, and toes and learn about adding stitch patterns. \$55 class fee.

Please note that this is not a sock project class but rather an opportunity to experiment with techniques that you could use to create your own sock pattern.

Although not required, **The Sock Knitter's Handbook** by Charlene Church and Beth Parrott would be a useful reference resource.

Out of the Ordinary - Cindy's Annual Afghan

For 2017, Cindy has designed an afghan using a variety of unusual stitch patterns. Out of the Ordinary meets monthly and begins in January and finishes in December. There are two sections, both will meet on the same Sundays: one at 12:30 and the other at 3:30. The dates are 1/22, 2/19, 3/19, 4/23, 5/21, 6/18, 7/16, 8/20, 9/17, 10/15, 11/19 and 12/17.

The class fee is \$65 and includes the pattern. Worsted weight yarn is recommended. You can choose to make it all in one color or multiple colors, keeping in mind that stitch patterns show best in lighter colors.
